Tentative Ireland Itinerary*

Day 1, Sept. 21: Depart USA on overnight flights to Ireland's capital city, Dublin.

Day 2, Sept. 22 DUBLIN | GALWAY: Arrive at Dublin Airport where you will be met with a *cead mile failte* (a hundred thousand welcomes) by Steve and Janet Ray and Irish Catholic tour escort/storyteller, Batt Burns. Head west through the Midlands of Ireland to Galway where you will enjoy its rich history, quaint narrow streets, shops, galleries and lively pubs with great traditional music. ***Celebrate opening Mass at Galway Cathedral.*** Welcome Dinner hosted by Steve and Janet Ray and overnight in Galway. **(D)**

Day 3, Sept 23: KNOCK SHRINE | GALWAY: After breakfast Batt will give a short presentation entitled “ An Introduction to Ireland”. He will give a little of his own background as well as some basic facts about Ireland's history, physical geography, climate, economy, language and culture. Then depart for a visit to Ireland's most famous pilgrimage site at Knock in County Mayo. Here learn about the 1879 apparition of Our Lady, then ***celebrate Mass in the Apparition Chapel of Knock Shrine.*** Travel on to Claremorris for lunch, then visit the small village of Cong, where most of the 1951 movie “The Quiet Man” (Maureen O'Hara and John Wayne) was filmed. Travel around Lough Corrib and Connemara, Ireland's most extensive Gaelic speaking area, before returning to Galway. Dinner on your own and overnight in Galway. Tonight Batt will advise of good pubs where there will be great Irish music and time to mix with local people. **(B)**

Day 4, Sept. 24: GALWAY | SNEEM: Depart Galway and travel south to Bunratty Castle, one of the best restored castles in Ireland. Have a guided tour followed by time to visit the folk park. Continuing on to Limerick City, drive by King John's Castle and St. Mary's Cathedral. Also see places associated with Frank Mc Court's famous book “Angela's Ashes”. Stop briefly in the pretty village of Adare with its distinctive thatched houses. In the afternoon arrive in Killarney, with its wonderful scenery that includes Killarney National Park. ***Celebrate Mass in the beautiful neo-Gothic St. Mary's Cathedral.*** Travel to Batt's home village for dinner and overnight in Sneem Hotel located on the estuary of Sneem River, a five minute walk from the colorful prizewinning village of Sneem. Here you will get an opportunity to sample Irish rural life in a village of 350 people. Overnight in Sneem. **(B, D)**

Day 5, Sept. 25: RING OF KERRY | SNEEM: After a full Irish breakfast meet Batt's wife, Maura, who will play some traditional Irish music on her concertina. She comes from a family of musicians and has an interesting story to tell. She will have you singing a Gaelic song !! Then depart for a tour of the famous Ring of Kerry, which includes the beautiful Killarney National Park. Also, visit the grounds and gardens of beautiful Muckross House. You will have the options of touring the house, taking a jaunting car (horse and buggy) ride into the Killarney National Park or simply enjoying the lovely gardens. Visit the 15th century Franciscan Abbey nearby. ***Celebrate evening Mass in Sneem Church.*** Dinner in a village restaurant and overnight in the Sneem Hotel. Tonight Batt will host a traditional evening of Irish music, song and dance in one of the village pubs. Top class entertainers will be invited in to perform and a group of village set dancers will dance an ancient Sneem Set dance. Many villagers will join in the fun and you will have an opportunity to chat with the locals. **(B, D)**

Day 6, Sept. 26 SNEEM | KILKENNY: Travel over the Cork/Kerry border to Blarney Castle with its famous Blarney Stone. Ample time here to kiss the Blarney Stone, if you so wish, and to shop in the extensive Blarney Woolen Mills, which houses gifts and crafts from throughout Ireland. After lunch, visit the Rock of Cashel, Ireland's most important ancient religious site. See a perfectly preserved Round Tower, the magnificent Cormac's Chapel, the 14th century ruined cathedral, the bishop's residence and the well-restored Vicar's Choral. ***Celebrate evening Mass in the beautifully restored Holy Cross Abbey*** which houses a relic of the True Cross. Move on to the medieval city of Kilkenny with its magnificent castle. Dinner followed by Batt's one man show entitled “Whisperings of Ireland.” Overnight in Kilkenny. **(B, D)**

Day 7, Sept 27: KILKENNY | DUBLIN: Take a walkabout in Kilkenny, and have time to visit the Kilkenny Design Workshops where skilled crafts people display their wares. Travel on to Glendalough, the site of St. Kevin's famous monastery, an oasis of spirituality, in County Wicklow, known as the Garden of Ireland. ***Celebrate Mass in nearby Laragh Church.*** Move on to Dublin, Ireland's capital city. Dinner and overnight in a city center hotel. Overnight in Dublin. **(B, D)**

Day 8, Sept. 28: CITY TOUR | DUBLIN: Morning visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral where Jonathan Swift was once Dean. Later, visit Phoenix Park and see the residences of the President of Ireland and that of The US Ambassador. Learn about Dublin writers George Bernard Shaw, William Butler Yeats, James Joyce, Samuel Beckett and others. Enjoy the Georgian architecture of Merrion Square where Batt will do a short presentation at the statue of Oscar Wilde. ***Evening Mass in Dublin's Pro-Cathedral.*** Dinner on your own and overnight in Dublin. **(B)**

Day 9, Sept. 29: BOOK OF KELLS | DUBLIN: After a full Irish breakfast visit Trinity College. See the magnificent Book of Kells, an illuminated copy of the Four Gospels. Visit Newman House and ***celebrate Mass at St. Teresa's Church,*** just off Grafton Street. This afternoon is free to do some last minute shopping in the Grafton and Nassau Street areas or sightsee on your own to see the wonderful National Museum, Guinness Brewery, Jameson Distillery, or a tour of the Kilmainham Gaol, which was a notorious prison during British occupation where many Irish patriots were imprisoned and executed. Farewell Gala Dinner at Merry Ploughboy. Overnight in Dublin. **(B, D)**

Day 10, Sept. 30: RETURN TO USA: Bid goodbye to the Emerald Isle and new found friends with return flight from Dublin Airport.

PAYMENT: In order to meet deposit schedules with suppliers for this tour, Corporate Travel Service asks for prompt payment on the requested dates. The advertised price is based on 100 passengers, tariffs, exchange rates, air line fuel surcharges and taxes in effect when the tour was organized and are subject to increase before tour departure. Price of the tour may have to be adjusted before final payment to reflect any increase in tariffs, fluctuation in exchange rates and/or fuel surcharges.

Corporate Travel Service accepts cash, check, money orders and Visa and MasterCard for payment. Traveler agrees not to dispute any credit card charges associated with this trip. GROUP AIR: Due to the airlines' reduced capacity and restrictive group reservation terms, group air reservations are often difficult to coordinate. GRATUITIES: Gratuities for your escort, driver and guides are included.

ROOMS: Tour prices are per person according to a room type: a "Single" room is one person in a room and a "Double" is two persons in one room. "Triple" rooms are discouraged because of cramped quarters. Triples are one double bed with two persons sharing the bed and one single bed. Triples are not always available. Single rooms are limited in Israel and are available first come-first served until the supply is exhausted.

LUGGAGE: Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour.

Checked Luggage: Checked baggage is limited to one bag per person. There can be no exceptions. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to **50 pounds and 62 inches** (length + width + height). If these specifications are exceeded, excess charges may be collected by the airline at the airport. Do not lock baggage you intend to check in at the airport. Please confirm these specifications when you receive your final travel documents, as they can and do change.

Carry On Luggage: You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under an airline seat and on the small parcel racks of the motor coach, which average about 8 inches high by 18 inches deep. It is best if your carry-on bag is soft sided, as the parcel racks on the motor coaches are small. Currently, travelers are allowed to transport only small amounts of liquids, gels, lotions, aerosols or similar items on their person or in their carry-on luggage. Details will be in your final travel documents.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Travelers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. This tour requires significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions. The tour is not wheelchair accessible. Any special medical conditions or equipment must be advised in writing, for evaluation of feasibility, at the time of making your reservation.

CHILDREN UNDER 18: For a minor under the age of 18 to travel out of the United States without both parents or legal guardians, a notarized affidavit must be obtained and presented to immigration official upon departure and return to the United States. You may request a form from our office. *Children must be at least 6 years old to travel.*

STATE DEPARTMENT & OTHER AGENCIES: From time to time the State Department (www.state.gov) and the Centers for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) and other government agencies and departments issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations that you may be visiting on tour. We encourage you to contact these agencies directly to obtain the most current information. Corporate Travel Service cannot change the cancellation terms or conditions based on the issuance of any such warning or advisory or the occurrence of any terror, health or other incident in one or more of the places this tour is scheduled to visit. All cancellation penalties must remain in full force and effect as outlined on the reservation form.

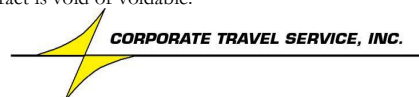
