



Day 1 ~ September 11: Departure from USA

Departure from the United States.

Day 2 ~ September 12: Arrival in Israel | Galilee | Tiberias

Arrival in Tel Aviv's modern Ben Gurion Airport. Meet your local guide and transfer to Galilee. Upon arrival, meet up with Steve and Janet Ray and the pre-trip passengers. Mass and dinner on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 3 ~ September 13: Mount of Transfiguration | Cana | Tiberias



Ascend the Mount of Transfiguration (Mount Tabor) early for Mass to miss the crowds; then depart for the Wedding Church in Cana for Renewal of Wedding Vows. After lunch in Nazareth, visit the Church of Annunciation. Visit the

House of the Holy Family. Free time. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 4 ~ September 14: Mount of Beatitudes | Tabgha | Tiberias

Mount of Beatitudes for Mass. Continue on to Caesarea Philippi where Jesus said, "You are Peter (Rock)!" Drive through Golan Heights; view the Syrian border. Lunch at Druze restaurant. Visit Tabgha where Jesus multiplied the loaves and fishes. Visit the Primacy of Peter where Jesus said, "Feed My sheep". Dinner at Magdalena Restaurant. Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 5 ~ September 15: Sea of Galilee | Capernaum | Jerusalem

Today enjoy a boat ride on Sea of Galilee. Arrive by boat to Capernaum for Mass at St. Peter's House and the synagogue where Jesus said "Eat My Flesh!" Hear Steve's famous talk on the Eucharist. St. Peter's fish for lunch. Drive to Jerusalem stopping along the way at Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6 ~ September 16: Bethlehem | Jerusalem

Spend the day in Bethlehem. Visit the local Christian store to support local Christians. Mass at Shepherd's Field and visit the Church of the Nativity where Jesus was born.

Special dinner in Bedouin Tent with traditional dancing in Bethlehem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 ~ September 17: Via Dolorosa | Calvary | Mt. Zion | Jerusalem

Depart early this morning and travel along the Via Dolorosa. Arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Touch the top of Mount Calvary. Mass at the tomb of Christ (subject to confirmation). Drive to the Mount of Olives to visit the Church of Pater Noster. At the scenic promenade, hear Steve give his invigorating History of Salvation in 20 minutes. Enjoy lunch at Jewish kibbutz. Drive to Mt. Zion to visit the Church of the Dormition and the Upper Room ending at the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Dinner at the Wine and Cheese Restaurant on the roof of the Notre Dame Center overlooking Jerusalem and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 ~ September 18: Gethsemane | Western Wall | Jerusalem

Begin today with Mass at the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of St. Ann where Mary was born and the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed a crippled man. Enter through the Dung Gate to pray at the Western Wall. Free time this afternoon. Optional tour of the Shroud of Turin Exhibit and extra shopping time. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.



Day 9 ~ September 19: Free Day | Optional Dead Sea Excursion | Jerusalem

Celebrate morning Mass at Notre Dame Chapel. Bring your rosaries and other religious items for blessing. Free day for shopping, prayer, rest, personal visit to Holy Sepulchre, or optional side trips. Optional Excursion (tour escort will advise price) to the Ancient Jerusalem Temple model and shrine of the Book, Qumran, Jericho and swimming in the Dead Sea. We will renew Baptismal vows at the authentic baptismal site of Jesus. We also have Sammie the Camel ready to give you a ride. We keep your room for you so you can return to the hotel to shower, pack, rest and eat. This evening get ready for flights through the night back home.

Day 10 ~ September 20: Return to USA

Depart on your return flights back to the USA.



Day 1 🛫 September 7: Depart USA

Depart USA for Amman.

Day 2 🛫 September 8: Arrive in Jordan | Amman

Arrival at Amman Queen Alia International Airport. You will be greeted upon arrival by Steve and Janet Ray and by our Jordanian Catholic guide Elias Khuz. If time permits panoramic tour of Amman (pending flight arrival time). Mass at Amman Peace Center. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Amman.

Day 3 🛫 September 9: Anjara | Jerash | Jabbok River

Mass at the Our Lady of the Mountain Church in Anjara, a pilgrimage site. Tour the fantastic Roman city of Jerash, one of the best preserved Roman archaeological sites. Visit Mar Elias (Tishbe, hometown of Prophet Elijah, 1 Kings 17:1). Lunch at local authentic restaurant. Visit Jabbok River where Jacob wrestled with the Angel. Back to Amman for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 🛫 September 10: Madaba | Jordan Valley | Machaerus

Drive to the mountain village of Madaba. Mass at Mount Nebo. Look out over the Jordan Valley and Israel like Moses did before he died here. See where Joshua crossed over the Jordan River. Visit St. George's Church to see the famous Madaba "Holy Land Mosaic Map." Themed lunch at Elias Khuz's family restaurant. Visit to the mosaic factory and store. Drive to Petra. See Machaerus where John the Baptist was imprisoned and beheaded. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Days 5 🛫 September 11: Petra

Visit Petra all morning. Lunch at Petra. Transfer back to Amman and stop en route for Mass at the Our Lady of Peace Center with some of the most beautiful biblical art covering the walls. Dinner and overnight in Amman.

Day 6 🛫 September 12: Bethany

Drive to Bethany-beyond-the-Jordan for Mass at the site where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. Visit site and the new Catholic Church being built. Continue on to Sheikh Hussein Bridge to cross into Israel. Drive to your hotel in Tiberias to meet up with the main trip group.

CAPACITY: This pilgrimage is limited to 2 buses with 106 pilgrim capacity.

PAYMENT TERMS: In order to meet deposit schedules with suppliers for this tour, CTS asks for prompt payment on the requested dates. Please see the reservation form for the payment schedule. Late payments may result in cancellation of your reservation. CTS also accepts Visa and MasterCard for payment. Traveler agrees not to dispute any credit card charges associated with this trip.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations must be received in writing. Forfeit \$100 for cancellations between time of deposit and 4/14/18. Forfeit \$350 for cancellations between 4/15/18 and 06/03/18. Forfeit \$1,600 for cancellation between 06/04/18 and 07/13/18. After 07/13/18, there will be no refund. Penalties will be according to the fax or postmark date.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: CTS highly suggests the purchase of travel protection, to help protect travelers' investment in the trip, and to help provide certain medical coverage while they are outside the USA. Plans help provide coverage for unexpected circumstances and help protect your trip and your investment. PASSPORT: A valid U.S. Passport is required of all passengers. Please apply for your passport immediately as passports may take a long time to process. Make sure to have it in your possession at all times while on tour. It must be valid for 6 months following the return date of the trip or boarding or entry into the destination may be denied. Please provide CTS with a copy of the inside page of your passport (showing your name and photo) at the time of reservation.

GROUP AIR:

Group Air Restrictions: Due to the airlines' reduced capacity and restrictive group reservation terms, group air reservations are often difficult to coordinate. The number of connections, length of layovers, and all conditions surrounding air travel cannot be guaranteed and may change before departure. Accordingly, if you require specific air travel needs and are not flexible concerning group air travel, you may wish to consider purchasing a Land-Only package and secure your own preferred air arrangements.

Deviations: Not allowed on group air tickets. If you want to travel on different dates, you must take travel land only (see topic below) and purchase your own independent flight tickets.

Group Air Seat Assignments: Please note that group seats are assigned "at the discretion of the airline", although every effort will be made to fulfill requests, SPECIFIC SEAT ASSIGNMENTS CANNOT AND WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED. Seat numbers will not be advised until check in at the airport. If you require specific seats, CTS suggests you book the tour package as "land only" and arrange your own air. Note that 'bulkhead' and 'exit row' seats are assigned by the carrier at the airport.

Group Air Mileage Credit - Reduced: It is common for carriers to give partial or no credit for group flights. It is important to give your frequent flyer number when checking in at the airport to make sure any eligible miles will be recorded.

Group Air Not Upgradable: Group Air is economy class and is not upgradable to first class, business, economy plus, etc. To travel with an upgrade, you must choose "Land Only" and book independent air. (See "Land Only" topic.)

Land Only: Those electing to make their own air arrangements will travel "Land Only". In this case, you must notify CTS no less than 120 days before departure, be responsible for meeting the group at a specified location and time on the tour, and sign a CTS Land Only Waiver. Land only passengers are responsible for arranging and the cost of transfers to and from the airport. **Do not purchase independent airline tickets until notified in writing that the minimum number of passengers has been met to operate the trip.**

Flight Cancellations and Delays: CTS will not be responsible for any loss incurred by

travelers due to a cancelled flight or other means of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel protection to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation.

Hazardous Materials: Federal law forbids the carriage of hazardous materials aboard the aircraft, in your luggage, or on your person. A violation can result in five years imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 USD or more(49 U.S.C. 5124). Hazardous materials include explosives, compressed gases, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, corrosives, and radioactive materials.

DOMESTIC AIR TO NEW YORK: You are responsible for your own air arrangements to New York. You will be notified of the international gateway airport (JFK or EWR) about 60 days prior to departure. Do not buy domestic air before hand.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Unless otherwise notified, CTS will mail you your travel information approximately 10-14 days before departure.

ITINERARY: The Itinerary as presented in this brochure is tentative and represents what we are planning for you, however it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates and/or venues to better fit the overall plan. The right is reserved to alter or cancel the itinerary, at CTS's sole discretion, as it may deem necessary or advisable.

GRATUITIES: Gratuities for your escort, driver and guides are included.

ROOMS: Tour prices are per person according to a room type: a "Single" room is one person in a room and a "Double" is two persons in one room. Triples are one double bed with two persons sharing the bed and one single bed. Triples are not always available and are discouraged because of cramped quarters.

LUGGAGE: Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour.

Checked Baggage: Fees are not included in this tour package price. Most airlines charge fees ranging from free to \$75 per bag one way. If traveling with group air, the air carrier for your flight will be announced in your final travel documents and an online link provided to learn the exact charges of your carrier. (Note: The website [iflybags.com](#) may be helpful and gives sample fees for all carriers.) Checked baggage is limited to **one bag per person**. There can be no exceptions. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to **50 pounds and 62 inches** (length + width + height). If these specifications are exceeded, excess charges may be collected by the airline at the airport. Do not lock baggage you intend to check in at the airport. Please confirm these specifications when you receive your final travel documents, as they can and do change.

Carry On Luggage: You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under an airline seat and on the small parcel racks of the motor coach, which average about 8 inches high by 18 inches deep. It is best if your carry-on bag is soft sided, as the parcel racks on the motor coaches are small. Currently, travelers are allowed to transport only small amounts of liquids, gels, lotions, aerosols or similar items on their person or in their carry-on luggage. Details will be in your final travel documents.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Travelers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. This tour requires significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions. The tour is not wheelchair accessible and is not suitable for motorized scooters, walkers, and canes. Any special medical conditions or equipment must be advised in writing, for evaluation of feasibility, at the time of making your reservation.
