






# OPTIONAL PRE-TRIP TO JORDAN

Planned Tentative Itinerary\*

You will be accompanied every day by Steve & Janet Ray along with their excellent Roman Catholic local guide.

## DAY 1 | FEBRUARY 7 🐫 Depart USA

Depart USA for Amman.

## DAY 2 | FEBRUARY 8 🐫 Arrive in Jordan | Amman

Arrival at Amman Queen Alia International Airport. You will be greeted upon arrival by Steve and Janet Ray and by our Jordanian Catholic guide Elias Khzuz. If time permits panoramic tour of Amman (pending flight arrival time). Mass at Amman Peace Center. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Amman.

## DAY 3 | FEBRUARY 9 🐫 Anjara | Jerash | Jabbok River

Mass at the Our Lady of the Mountain Church in Anjara, a pilgrimage site. Tour the fantastic Roman city of Jerash, one of the best preserved Roman archaeological sites. Visit Mar Elias (Tishbe, hometown of Prophet Elijah, 1 Kings 17:1). Lunch at local authentic restaurant. Visit Jabbok River where Jacob wrestled with the Angel. Back to Amman for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 4 | FEB. 10 🐫 Madaba | Jordan Valley | Machaerus | Petra

Drive to the mountain village of Madaba. Mass at Mount Nebo. Look out over the Jordan Valley and Israel like Moses did before he died here. See where Joshua crossed over the Jordan River. Visit St. George's Church to see the famous Madaba "Holy Land Mosaic Map." Themed lunch at Elias Khzuz's family restaurant. Visit to the mosaic factory and store. Drive to Petra. See Machaerus where John the Baptist was imprisoned and beheaded. Dinner and overnight in Petra.


## DAYS 5 | FEBRUARY 11 🐫 Petra

Visit Petra all morning. Lunch at Petra. Transfer back to Amman and stop en route for Mass at the Our Lady of Peace Center with some of the most beautiful biblical art covering the walls. Dinner and overnight in Amman.

## DAY 6 | FEBRUARY 12 🐫 Bethany | Jordan River

Drive to Bethany-beyond-the-Jordan for Mass at the site where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. Stop at the authentic site to renew our baptismal vows. Visit site and the new Catholic Church being built. Continue on to Sheikh Hussein Bridge to cross into Israel. Drive to your hotel in Tiberias to meet up with the main trip group.

# STEVE RAY HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE

Planned Tentative Itinerary\*

## DAY 1 | FEBRUARY 12 🕊️ Depart USA

Departure from the United States on overnight flights to Tel Aviv.

## DAY 2 | FEBRUARY 12 🕊️ Arrival in Tiberias

Arrival in Tel Aviv's modern Ben Gurion Airport. Meet Steve and Janet Ray along with the local team. Transfer to Galilee. Mass and dinner on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Overnight in Tiberias.

## DAY 3 | FEBRUARY 13 🕊️ Golan Heights | Sea of Galilee | Kursi | Bethsaida | Chorazin | Tiberias

This morning we drive to the Golan Heights on the other side of the Sea of Galilee. Celebrate an outdoor Mass. We then descend to view the other place Jesus multiplied loaves and fish and where he walked on the water. From there to Kursi where Jesus healed the man of the Gadarenes plagued by unclean spirits. (Mark 5:21). Drive to Bethsaida (birthplace of Saint Peter and Andrew and Philip), birthplace of Peter, Andrew and Philip (John 1:44, 12:21). In Bethsaida we will have a light picnic lunch. Drive to Chorazin (Korazim) a city Jesus cursed and see a replica of the chair of Moses. Visit Katzin for a walk through a restored Talmudic village. Visit the Yarden Winery for a tour and wine tasting. End the day with a fabulous dinner at Magdalena Restaurant. Night at hotel in Tiberias.

## DAY 4 | FEBRUARY 14 🕊️ Sepphoris | Nazareth | Tel Magiddo | Nein | Tiberias

Drive to Sepphoris near Nazareth which once served as a center of Jewish religious and spiritual life in the Galilee. It is supposed that Joseph and Jesus worked in Sepphoris. Continue on to Nazareth to visit Angel Gabriel Greek Orthodox church. Visit the spring where Mary daily drew water. Visit Catholic Church of Annunciation. After local food for lunch in Nazareth we will drive to Tel Megiddo. We will walk through the Tel and see the Gates of Solomon (1 Kings 9:15) and exit through a tunnel built by King Ahab. Our last stop today is the village of Nein for Mass where Jesus raised a widow's son from the dead. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

## DAY 5 | FEBRUARY 15 🕊️ Samaria | Shiloh | Sebastia | Tiberias

We will visit Samaria and the well where Jesus took the drink from the Samaritan woman (John 4). We will stop at Shiloh where Joshua placed the Ark of the Covenant in the tabernacle (Joshua 18:1). Visit Sebastia. Celebrate Mass. Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 6 | FEBRUARY 16 🕊️ Acco | Murhaka | Caesarea Maritime | Jaffa | Jerusalem

Depart Galilee and travel to Jerusalem. Travel to Acco (Akko or Acre) to tour the impressive fortress remains where Christian Crusaders attempted to retake the Holy Land from the Muslims (1099-1291). Next we drive to Mt. Carmel to visit the Cave of Elijah (1 Kings 18) and celebrate Mass at Murhaka, the

mountain where the prophet Elijah called down fire from heaven. Continue to Caesarea Maritime, the Roman capital of Judea. Here St. Peter baptized Cornelius (Acts 10:24) and St. Paul was imprisoned for two years before he was sent to Rome (Acts 24:27). Travel to Jaffa where Peter healed Dorcas. Continue to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 7 | FEBRUARY 17 🕊️ Bethlehem | Hebron | Cave of Machpelah | Hebron | Jerusalem

Drive to Bethlehem and with time for shopping at a local Christian store. Mass with the Seminarians in the Bethlehem seminary. Visit Elah Valley where David killed Goliath and learn how to sling a stone. Drive south to Hebron and see the Oaks of Mamre. Visit the Cave of Machpelah where Abraham is buried. Lunch in Hebron. In the afternoon we drive to the Herodian, a fortress of King Herod. On our way back stop at Milk Grotto if time allows. Shepherd's Field, Beit Sahour and dinner and dance at the Grotto Restaurant. Overnight in Jerusalem.

## DAY 8 | FEBRUARY 18 🕊️ Temple Mount | Bethany | Jericho | Jerusalem

Enter the Old City through the Dung Gate to Temple Mount above the Western Wall; location of the Temple until it was destroyed in 70 AD. Current location of the Moslem shrines of Al Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Drive to Bethany for Mass where Jesus stayed with Mary, Martha and Lazarus. Visit and go into tomb of Lazarus. Drive to Jericho for tour and lunch. Walk along portion of the Good Samaritan Road. Back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 9 | FEBRUARY 19 🕊️ City of David | Pool of Siloam | Church of St. Stephen | Jerusalem

Early morning Mass at the Latin Patriarchate with the Bishop of Jerusalem (pending confirmation). Then take a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Visit the cathedral dedicated to St. James, son of Zebedee and James the Less. Continue through the Jewish Quarter, the wall of Nehemiah, the City of David, the Springs of Gihon and walk through Hezekiah Tunnel (optional and as time allows). We will arrive at the Pool of Siloam (John 9). Visit the Garden Tomb for educational purposes. After lunch we will celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Stephen the Deacon. Dinner at the Wine and Cheese Restaurant atop the Notre Dame Hotel and overnight.

## DAY 10 | FEBRUARY 20 🕊️ Holy Sepulchre | Return Flight

Early morning Mass at Church of Holy Sepulchre and tour. Nearby we will visit Pre-crucifixion Herodian Walls that prove Christ was actually crucified outside the city walls. Free afternoon. Transfer to the airport this evening for return flight.

## DAY 11 | FEBRUARY 21 🕊️ Return to USA

Flights arrive back in the USA.

Accordingly, if you require specific air travel needs and are not flexible concerning group air travel, you may wish to consider purchasing a Land-Only package and secure your own preferred air arrangements.

**DEVIATIONS:** Not allowed on group air tickets. If you want to travel on different dates, you must take travel land only (see topic below) and purchase your own independent flight tickets.

**GROUP AIR SEAT ASSIGNMENTS:** Please note that group seats are assigned "at the discretion of the airline", although every effort will be made to fulfill requests, **SPECIFIC SEAT ASSIGNMENTS CANNOT AND WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED.** Seat numbers will not be advised until check in at the airport. If you require specific seats, Corporate Travel suggests you book the tour package as "Land Only" and arrange your own air. Note that 'bulkhead' and 'exit row' seats are assigned by the carrier at the airport.

**GROUP AIR MILEAGE CREDIT - REDUCED:** It is common for carriers to give partial or no credit for group flights. It is important to give your frequent flyer number when checking in at the airport to make sure any eligible miles will be recorded.

**GROUP AIR NOT UPGRADABLE:** Group Air is economy class and is not upgradable to first class, business, economy plus, etc. To travel with an upgrade, you must choose "Land Only" and book independent air. (See "Land Only" topic.)

**LAND ONLY:** Those electing to make their own air arrangements will travel "Land Only". In this case, you must notify Corporate Travel no less than 120 days before departure, be responsible for meeting the group at a specified location and time on the tour, and sign a Corporate Travel Land Only Waiver. Land only passengers are responsible for arranging and the cost of transfers to and from the airport. **NOTE: Do not purchase independent Air Tickets until notified in writing that the minimum group size has been met and the trip will definitely operate.**

**FLIGHT CANCELLATIONS AND DELAYS:** Corporate Travel will not be responsible for any loss incurred by travelers due to a cancelled flight or other means of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel protection to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation.

**DOMESTIC AIR TO NEW YORK** You are responsible for your own air arrangements to New York. You will be notified of the international gateway airport (JFK or EWR) about 60 days prior to departure. Do not buy domestic air before hand.

**HAZARDOUS MATERIALS:** Federal law forbids the carriage of hazardous materials aboard the aircraft, in your luggage, or on your person. A violation can result in five years imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 USD or more (49 U.S.C. 5124). Hazardous materials include explosives, compressed gases, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, corrosives, and radioactive materials.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** Unless otherwise notified, CTS will mail you your travel information approximately 10-14 days before departure.

**ITINERARY:** The itinerary as presented in this brochure is tentative and represents what we are planning for you, however it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates and/or venues to better fit the overall plan. The right is reserved to alter or cancel the itinerary, at CTS's sole discretion, as it may deem necessary or advisable.

**GRATUITIES:** Gratuities for your driver and escort/guides are included.

**ROOMS:** Tour prices are per person according to a room type: a "Single" room is one person in a room and a "Double" is two persons in one room. Triples are one double bed with two persons sharing the bed and one single bed. Triples are not always available and are discouraged because of cramped quarters. Note: Availability of single rooms is very limited.

**LUGGAGE:** Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour.

**CHECKED BAGGAGE: Fees are not included in this tour package price.** Most airlines charge fees ranging from free to \$75 per bag one way. If traveling with group air, the air carrier for your flight will be announced in your final travel documents and an online link provided to learn the exact charges of your carrier. (Note: The website [flybags.com](http://flybags.com) may be helpful and gives sample fees for all carriers.) Checked baggage is limited to **one** bag per person. There can be no exceptions. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to **50 pounds and 62 inches** (length + width + height). If these specifications are exceeded, excess charges may be collected by the airline at the airport. Do not lock baggage you intend to check in at the airport. Please confirm these specifications when you receive your final travel documents, as they can and do change.

**CARRY ON LUGGAGE:** You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under an airline seat and on the small parcel racks of the motor coach, which average about 8 inches high by 18 inches deep. It is best if your carry-on bag is soft sided, as the parcel racks on the motor coaches are small. Currently, travelers are allowed to transport only small amounts of liquids, gels, lotions, aerosols or similar items on their person or in their carry-on luggage. Details will be in your final travel documents.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Travelers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. This tour requires significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions. The tour is not wheelchair accessible and is not suitable for motorized scooters, walkers, and canes. Any special medical conditions or equipment must be advised in writing, for evaluation of feasibility, at the time of making your reservation. Should any special assistance be required, traveler agrees to bring a companion capable and willing to assist traveler.

**CHILDREN UNDER 18:** For a minor under the age of 18 to travel out of the United States without both parents or legal guardians, a notarized affidavit from the non-travelling parent(s) or guardian(s) must be obtained and presented upon departure and return to the United States. You may request a form from our office.

**STATE DEPARTMENT & OTHER AGENCIES:** From time to time the State Department ([www.state.gov](http://www.state.gov)) and the Center for Disease Control ([www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov)) and other government agencies and departments issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations that you may be visiting on tour. We encourage you to contact these agencies directly to obtain the most current information. CTS cannot change the cancellation terms or conditions based on the issuance of any such warning or advisory or the occurrence of any terror, health or other incident in one or more of the places this tour is scheduled to visit. All cancellation penalties remain in full force and effect.

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** CTS may take photographs or film of its trips and trip participants, and participant grants CTS express permission to do so and for CTS to use such for promotional or commercial use without payment of any fee or royalties.

**UNUSED SERVICES:** There is no right to a refund for any unused services including airline tickets.

**PARTIAL PACKAGES NOT AVAILABLE:** Tour Packages are offered only as described in this brochure, at the stated price. For liability reasons, it is not possible to purchase a partial package.

**CHANGES:** Changes in any of the terms and conditions can be made only in writing signed by an officer of CTS.

**PARTICIPATION:** CTS reserves the right to decline to accept or retain any participant on any of its tours if, in its sole discretion, it deems accepting or retaining any such participant as being detrimental to the tour. In the event any participant is removed from a trip, CTS's only obligation is to refund to that person that portion of the payment allocable to unused services.

**BINDING ARBITRATION:** I agree that any dispute concerning, relating or referring to this Agreement, the brochure or any other literature concerning my trip, or the trip itself, shall be resolved exclusively by binding arbitration pursuant to the Federal Arbitration Act, 9 U.S.C. §§1-16, either according to the then existing Commercial Rules of the American Arbitration Association (AAA) or pursuant to the Comprehensive Arbitration Rules & Procedures of the Judicial Arbitration and Mediation Services, Inc. (JAMS). Such proceedings will be governed by substantive (but not procedural) Michigan law and will take place in Detroit, MI. The arbitrator and not any federal, state, or local court or agency shall have exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability, conscionability, or formation of this contract, including but not limited to any claim that all or any part of this contract is void or voidable. Please understand that by agreeing to these terms and conditions, you (and we) are waiving our right to a trial by jury.
